Zero-clearance fireplaces are typically installed during the construction of a new home or as a part of a remodel project. Zero-clearance fireplaces are designed to be framed into a wall without the need to be contained in a pre-existing wood-burning fireplace. If you have a pre-existing masonry or zero-clearance wood fireplace ask your dealer about the many gas insert options that Travis Industries offers and consult with them about what type of appliance is most appropriate for your application.
